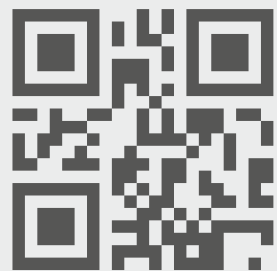

The most concrete steps toward Globalisation were taken in the mid-1990s. It was a well-intentioned liberal investment, which would make perfect sense from a macroeconomic point of view.

These measures would bring about flourishing economic development followed by stronger companies and more jobs, thus raising living conditions to new and improved standards.

Theoretically, it all makes sense - and in practice, it has made some sense too. However, failed trade agreements in the textile sector have severely harmed Europe in relation to its Asian counterparts.

This is because Asian barriers to receiving textiles are enormous, while European barriers to importing Asian textiles are practically non-existent.

And, as far as this matter is concerned, Globalisation was inefficient. Today, the Globalisation dream is fading, not because of the injustices in global trade agreements, but because of factors unrelated to trade, among which stands out the pandemic. This global health phenomenon has encouraged production in Europe to the detriment of Asia, not only due to travel impairments but also because of the differences between the vaccines and protocols adopted.

Another relevant factor is the European political-security framework - particularly that of Portugal - which are guarantors of a stable solution to external conflicts.

Equally important is the carbon footprint – a factor that is significantly reduced when production takes place in Europe, as compared to production in Asia.

The trend has thus become to produce in Europe, which is why communication acquires such relevance.
